The hustings have been organised by Great Shelford Parish Council and will be chaired by Mike Nettleton, Chair of the Parish Council.

All the candidates will be attending:

- Heidi Allen – Conservative
- Dan Greef – Labour
- Susan van de Ven – Liberal Democrat
- Simon Saggors – Green

1. **Candidate speeches.** Each candidate will be asked to make an opening speech of up to four minutes on subject(s) of his/her choice. They will be reminded at 3½ minutes and stopped at four. Lots will be drawn for the 'batting order'. This should take about 20 minutes.

2. **Questions for all candidates.** Members of the public will be selected in turn to ask a single question to be answered by all candidates. Each candidate will then have 1½ minutes to answer the question (reminder at 1 minute, stop at 1½ minutes). Allowing half a dozen questions, this should take about 45 minutes.

3. **Questions for individual candidates.** Members of the public will be selected in turn to ask a single question to be answered by a chosen candidate. The candidate will then have two minutes to answer the question (reminder at 1½ minute, stop at two minutes). Allowing eight questions, this should take about 25 minutes.

4. **Close.** The hustings will close at 9p.m.

Any assistance with setting up the Hall from 1900 and clearing tables and chairs at the end would be very much appreciated.
