

- **LHI 2016 / Highways changes** : The project is nearing completion, outstanding issue around the “lay-by” in High Green as the required single yellow line cannot be put down as the surface needs repairing, the likely cost will be £3000 and we have asked CCC to proceed. CCC will be sending a camera down the drains in the area to resolve flooding in the lay-by. A review of the project timing and costs has been organised for the 11th October with Richard Lumley of CCC.
- **Additional White Lining (refresh)** – the lining is ongoing with that required for the extensive pot-hole repair work. The fact that the pot-holes have been repaired will mean savings to the PC as some of the refresh work will no longer be required.
- **Bus Stops** – Bus time’s indication at High Green, north bound working, south installed but not working due to issues with UKPN which CCC are progressing.
- **County Councillors** – we have requested a meeting with Councillors Hickford and Cuffley to discuss the performance of CCC Highways.
- **Bus Route 7A rerouting** – the route has now changed to terminate at Trumpington P&R, Stagecoach will not allow the 7A operator to use the Stagecoach stops, we are approaching the local MD of stagecoach (Andy Campbell) pressing him to change his stance.
- **LHI 2019** – bid submitted for two central refuges (for safer pedestrian crossing) in Cambridge Road, one near Scotsdales and one near Davey Crescent. We are waiting for the CCC cost and feasibility exercise to take place.
- **Grass Cutting** – we could extend grass cutting in the village to include some areas that are the responsibility of SCDC which they don’t cut on a regular basis. Review still to take place as we are struggling to get information from SCDC.
- **Additional TRO’s** – a list has been assembled and has initial approval from the PC, the changes will be finalised after the Open Highways Meeting on the 26th Sept, the final document then needs to be submitted to CCC.
- **Roads and Pavements Potholes** – we are considering a survey to create a master list.
- **Rural Travel Hub** – BA attended a meeting on 25th July in Sawston, the proposed “hub” at the junction of A1301 and Cambridge Road (Sawston) was rejected by the meeting as unworkable and a waste of financial resources. Other suggestions were made, we await feedback.
- **Parking** – Councillor Nettleton attended a meeting on 19th July to discuss decriminalisation with CCC, no firm outcomes but SCDC and the Police are in discussions.
- **Granhams Corner (land at junction A1301 and Granhams)** – a tidy-up has taken place and final clearance and fence repairs are in hand, we will now be in a position to undertake regular maintenance of the area.
- **Business Survey** – around 25 businesses have been circulated a short survey to complete regarding parking in GS and their impact on the lack of free spaces. To date we have had one reply.
- **Station Rd Crossing** – Network Rail have been approached about the poor state of the highway at the crossing, they have responded positively indicating that works to remedy the issues will take place,
- **Station Rd Crossing Idling Signs** – local residents have been approached to see if they are willing to mount a simple “no idling” sign on their fences / walls to try to influence more drivers to switch off whilst waiting at the crossing. If we are successful we will repeat at Granhams Crossing.
- **Heritage Direction Sign junction Woollards / High St** – one of the finger post signs is damaged, it will cost £2,400 to replace. We need views.
- **Gutter Weeds and Cleaning** – CCC advise that weed treatment will take place in September, we are trying to organise SCDC to sweep the gutters at least two weeks after the weeds have been sprayed.
- **Stapleford – Sawston Cycleway** – much work has taken place to improve the track (eg siding out and resurfacing), one outstanding item is the removal of the hedge at the Bridge Cottage which is due to be replaced with a fence which will make the path wider. We have reminded CCC that they have not completed the works and also asked Stapleford PC to advise the cottage owner that the hedge needs trimming back.
- **Notice Boards** – the notice board at the Cemetery (outside) is wooden and needs replacement, it is proposed that it’s changed to Aluminium and the slanting support posts rectified. The wooden one outside the Memorial Hall is on the verge of needing to be replaced, we could replace with a wooden one to maintain character or provide an aluminium one (price difference typically £2500 and £1500 in favour of Aluminium) – views needed.
