

## Community Association – report for PC Feb 2019

- An amendment to the lease between the PC and Community Association has been signed which removes the Sports and Social Club from the area leased by the Community Association.
- The Community Association have signed a cessation of lease document with the Sports and Social Club agreeing that the lease between the two parties can be brought to an end.
- SSYI will lease the “Sports and Social Club Area” directly from the PC, the lease fee will be nominal. We need to complete this so that we can begin the process of upgrading (some minor works have been done).
- At the last Community Association meeting (28<sup>th</sup> Jan) the PC presented some ideas on the possible provision of some public toilets on the ground floor. Cllr Nightingale in his capacity as a Trustee of the Community Association put forward some alternative areas, a further meeting with PC representatives concluded that the areas were not suitable.
- A front door key to the Memorial Hall has been issued to the Parish Clerk.
- The Football club continue to use the SSYI as an after-match venue, this will continue until the end of the season or before if the changes to the Pavilion kitchen are completed earlier.
