

Highways Report : PC Meeting 10 April 2019

- **Lining changes 2019** – a number of lining changes have been submitted to CCC, we await a response, if there were no problems we anticipate at least six months until we see physical changes.
- **Bus Route 7A rerouting** – the issue of allowing the 7A to stop at Stagecoach stops remains unresolved, MN to contact Stagecoach MD to make a case.
- **Roads and Pavements Potholes** – Cllr Harris-Wright to report
- **Station Rd Crossing Idling Signs** – approval for a largish light standard sign in Station Rd has been received, Cllr Harris-Wright to report on other signage.
- **Heritage Direction Sign junction Woollards / High St** – investigating possible supplier
- **Stapleford – Sawston Cycleway** – work has commenced on a series of improvements including widening the Sawston section of Cambridge Rd
- **High Green Layby** – we await action from CCC to undertake resurfacing and relining. This may cost around £3,000
- **Zebra Crossing** – we await progress on a possible safety surface by CCC. If we need the surface it could cost around £15,000
- **Costs** – we have received invoices for the crossing and all the lining changes that were completed late 2018, the total cost is £26,308.31.
- **LHI 2019** – we submitted a bid for central refuges in Cambridge Rd, we were unsuccessful.
- **Grass Cutting** – cutting has started for the summer months, every two weeks.
- **Bridge footpath London Rd** – we await Network Rail to undertake maintenance work, the 'local team' has been asked to make contact with the PC
- **SCDC works** – they have agreed to undertake groundworks improvements to allow easier mowing on the cut through from High Green to DeFreville and the area to the rear of the bungalows on DeFreville, the work remains outstanding.
