

Highways Report : PC Meeting 17th July 2019

- **Lining changes 2019** – a number of lining changes have been submitted to CCC, these have been checked for accuracy and returned. We await the consultation documents being issued.
- **Bus Route 7A rerouting** – the issue of allowing the 7A to stop at Stagecoach stops remains unresolved.
- **Heritage Direction Sign junction Woollards / High St** – investigating possible supplier
- **Stapleford – Sawston Cycleway** – work continues on the route which is used by many of our youngsters bike riding to Sawston Village College. Work is almost complete.
- **High Green Layby** – we await action from CCC to undertake resurfacing and relining. Initially the PC agreed to fund but CCC is now funding the works.
- **SCDC works** – are investigating some ‘cutting back’ on growth around trees on the DeFreville cut through. We have also received a request to put up signs requesting ‘dog walkers’ not to allow their dogs to foul the area.
- **Granhams Bridge Lining** – Local Highways Officer is investigating rectifying the faded lining which was only put down a few months ago.
- **Footpath outside 167 Cambridge Rd** – an order has been placed by CCC for remedial works to prevent flooding, this is scheduled for Sept.
- **Hinton Way** – CCC have undertaken extensive works on pot holes, drain clearance work towards Shelford Bottom needs to be completed as tree roots were found on the first visit and specialised equipment now needs to be ordered. PC has funded extensive hedge cutting in Hinton Way.
- **CGM Grass Cutting** – meeting to take place 18th July to discuss issues on the areas taken over from SCDC.
- **Local Highways Officer, John Obrien** – meeting took place on 8th July to discuss issues
 - JOB is discussing the issue of the ‘wearing away’ of lines after 6mths with the contractor
 - Discussed speed bumps in the High St, could see no reason that they could not be fitted. We will need to submit an application. BA will submit an LHI for 2020 funding?
 - General poor state of Woollards Lane (lining / potholes). JOB will progress
 - Knocked over power unit High St / Tunwells – JOB to progress repair
 - Gully cleaning – JOB suggested that if we had all gullies cleaned (PC to fund) and we identified issues with any he would progress any work needed.
 - Overhanging tree at lights Woollards / Tunwells – JOB has already issued letter asking the homeowner to undertake works (the PC has done the same). JOB will issue another letter advising the homeowner if the work is not done then CCC will undertake the work and charge them.
 - Spinney Drive – planned resurfacing last Friday
 - Ashen Green pavement at High St junction – JOB will investigate a repair
 - Tesco railings – JOB has investigated and sees no objection to the PC funding some. Railings would need to be 450mm from the carriageway. BA to ask for a costing?
 - Bus-Stop Barkers – CCC are putting new bus-stop flags and suggested a lamp post near Barkers, discussed with JOB possibility of a roadway marked bus bay, however after discussions at base JOB advised that it was not possible.
