

Highways Report : PC Meeting 20th March 2019

- **Lining changes 2019** – a number of lining changes have been submitted to CCC, we await a response, if there were no problems we anticipate at least six months until we see physical changes.
- **Idling Bus in High Green / Bus Route 7A rerouting** – along with the Chair met with local resident and Nigel Tarrant (Stagecoach) to discuss the ongoing issue of buses idling in High Green. Stagecoach were not receptive to possible solutions (tweek timetable, discipline for not switching off and relocating the stop used to idle). The PC explained that they are applying to CCC for a painted bus stop area more towards the crossing which may alleviate the issue. Stagecoach agreed to mount a no idling sign on the bus-stop. As regards the issue of allowing the 7A to stop at Stagecoach stops so that locals could have access to Waitrose there was a blank refusal, MN to contact Stagecoach MD to make a case.
- **Roads and Pavements Potholes** – Cllr Harris-Wright to report
- **Parking** – noted that the Co-op Sawston car-park now has a 2hr limit, we are investigating the method used.
- **Station Rd Crossing Idling Signs** – approval for a largish light standard sign in Station Rd has been received, Cllr Harris-Wright to report on other signage.
- **Heritage Direction Sign junction Woollards / High St** – the sign has been removed, Clerk investigating a possible supplier, there was no response from an article in GSVN asking for information on the missing section.
- **Stapleford – Sawston Cycleway** – the outstanding item is the removal of the hedge at the Bridge Cottage which is due to be replaced with a fence. CCC have got an agreement with the property owner and are submitting a planning request to SCDC.
- **High Green Layby** – we await action from CCC to undertake resurfacing and relining.
- **Zebra Crossing** – we await progress on a possible safety surface by CCC
- **Grass Cutting** – we intend taking over the grass cutting of areas presently cut by SCDC from 1st April – this will ensure we have full control.
- **Bridge footpath London Rd** – we await Network Rail to undertake maintenance work
- **Hinton Way** – CCC are gathering prices for extensive “pothole” works, we are in contact with the local Highways Officer. The issue was highlighted to CCC by a local resident.
- **SCDC works** – they have agreed to undertake groundworks improvements to allow easier mowing on the cut through from High Green to DeFreville and the area to the rear of the bungalows on DeFreville, and to undertake some tree pruning around Acacia Court. The issue of the “conifers” on Chaston Rd was aired (leave or trim etc) and the matter is being discussed with their groundworks contractor.
- **Bench Memorial Green** – the bench which had been the centre of noisy behaviour and littering has been moved to a more appropriate position.
