

Highways Report : PC Meeting 18th March

- **Lining changes 2019, PRO 542** – All the proposals are now approved by CCC. DYL changes in Red Hill Lane, Cherry Trees, The Hectare, Church St, Woollards Lane, Spinney Drive, Poplar Close, Leeway Ave, Chaston Rd and Hinton Way will now be progressed, some refreshing works will be undertaken along with a “keep clear” road signage at the Chaston Rd / Hinton Way junction.
- **Bus Route 7A rerouting – No progress with the bus operator and CCC** : the bus can now stop at Stagecoach bus-stops, we are currently working with CCC and the bus operator to see if the bus can stop /pickup at Waitrose.
- **Station Rd Crossing Idling Signs** – approval for a largish light standard sign in Station Rd has been received, we need to progress. **Councillor Townsend to update**
- **Heritage Direction Sign junction Woollards / High St** – investigating possible supplier
- **Stapleford – Sawston Cycleway** – the hedge adjacent to Bridge Cottage has been removed and replaced with a fence to improve cycle safety, the final tarmac is now completed. This has taken CCC over 12mths to implement.
- **SCDC works** – are investigating some ‘cutting back’ on growth around a tree on the DeFreville cut through, another diseased tree has been removed although the clearing up of the site is poor and Councillor Fane (SCDC) has been advised. **No progress from Councillor Fane.**
- **Meeting with CCC Highways**

A meeting took place with John Obrien and Dennis Vacher (CCC), Councillors Ashurst and Townsend, along with one resident on 10th March to discuss outstanding issues.

 - JOB is discussing the issue of the ‘wearing away’ of lines after 6mths, looking at a refresh in the next financial year, the dotted lines on Cambridge Rd railway bridge will be progressed urgently.
 - Woollards Lane, High Street and Station Rd will have extensive work undertaken during 2020-21 using the Rhino strip system. All lining will be refreshed as part of the process.
 - Gully cleaning – 5 identified gullies to be cleaned around Station Rd and Hinton asap. There is also a drain with identified issues of tree roots in Hinton (towards Shelford Bottom), this will be authorised now and progressed with some urgency..
 - Ashen Green pavement at High St junction – JOB has identified as a repair : awaiting timescale.
 - Tesco railings – JOB has had indication from the Project that it will not be progressed. BA asked JOB to ask John O’Donnell (CCC) to contact him to discuss in detail.
 - Cambridge Road Railway Bridge – CCC to progress urgently overhanging growth / soil creep over footpath to be removed immediately.
 - 167 Cambridge Rd : footpath floods, previous works unsuccessful : JOB and DV will take another look to speed up works.
 - Cambridge Rd bus-stop leaning pole (near May Pasture) will be replaced.
 - Another meeting will be organised in May to monitor progress.
 - High Green Lay-by : JOB to discuss with Stephen Marshall (CCC) the lining needed.
- **Local Highways Initiative 2020-2021** – Councillor Townsend attended Panel meeting on 3rd Feb, we await the outcome of our request for finance for speed bumps in the High Street and Church St.
- **Local Highways Initiative 2021-2020** – looking for input from other Councillors on any ideas.
