

# Great Shelford Parish Council Meeting 13 Jan 2021

## Highways – Key points

### **Double Yellow Lines PRO452**

The work has now been completed, some final finishing off is required in Spinney Drive and the loading bay in Woollards lane due to road surface issues (not possible to put lining down). No negative comments have been received.

- Cherry Trees
- The Hectare
- Church Street
- Woollards Lane (goods vehicles only bay 6am-6pm)
- Spinney Drive
- Poplar Close
- Leeway Ave

- Hinton – reduce parking bay near No 31

**Davey Crescent** – SCDC have indicated that they will start work on providing additional off road parking in the area in Q1 2021. There is a lot of verge damage (reported to SCDC) but a solution has not been forthcoming from SCDC, this is not primarily a Parish Council issue but the SCDC councillors have not been proactive on the issue.

**Drain / Gully Clearance** – no regular cleaning of highway gullies is undertaken by CCC, the PC is financing a private contractor to undertake some cleaning. As a starting point this is being done around the centre of the village. Five days of cleaning has taken place and others are planned.

**Road Traffic Accidents** – we are investigating the accidents recorded on the CCC website so that we can use the information as evidence in pursuing improvements. The data only indicate accidents with personal injury, if we were to require data on non-injury accidents we would need to contact the Business Intelligence team at CCC who can then request the information from the police (it is at the discretion of the police to provide the information).

**CCC Work in Great Shelford** – there are many outstanding jobs in GS, there are ongoing discussions with CCC.

**CGM** – our landscaping contractor has been issued with a list of work to undertake in the winter months and a start has been made on the works (eg trim front hedge to Cambridge Rd allotments, trim hedge Rayment car-park)

**Fly Tipping** – We've had a couple of fly tipping incidents in the last couple of months, one in Rayment's car park and one in the Memorial Hall car park. SCDC cleared away the rubbish on both occasions.

**Rat Run** – Cllr Disley and Talbott are in discussion with Little Shelford PC regarding the route from LS High St to GS Church St being a rat run and are exploring possible solutions.

**Church St Bus Timings No 31** – discussions are ongoing with A2B (the bus operator) regarding the bus timetable which routes the bus passed Shelford Primary School at critical times. Any changes need negotiation with CCC.
