

Great Shelford Parish Council Meeting 17 Feb 2021

Highways – Key points

Davey Crescent – SCDC have indicated that they will start work on providing additional off road parking in the area in Q1 2021. There is a lot of verge damage (reported to SCDC) but a solution has not been forthcoming from SCDC, this is not primarily a Parish Council issue but the SCDC councillors have not been proactive on the issue.

Drain / Gully Clearance – the PC has paid for a number of gullies to be cleaned in the centre of the village, some gullies are broken and we are awaiting information from our contractor as their location so we can then ask CCC to replace/repair.

Road Traffic Accidents – we are investigating the accidents recorded on the CCC website so that we can use the information as evidence in pursuing improvements. The data only indicate accidents with personal injury, if we were to require data on non-injury accidents we would need to contact the Business Intelligence team at CCC who can then request the information from the police (it is at the discretion of the police to provide the information).

CCC Work in Great Shelford – there are some outstanding jobs in GS the CCC have completed a number (13) in January, there are ongoing discussions with CCC. Woollards Lane contractor being chased for a start date.

CGM – our landscaping contractor has been issued with a list of work to undertake in the winter months and a start has been made on the works (eg trim front hedge to Cambridge Rd allotments, trim hedge Rayment car-park). Work continues.

Rat Run – Cllr Disley and Talbott are in discussion with Little Shelford PC regarding the route from LS High St to GS Church St being a rat run and are exploring possible solutions.

Church St Bus Timings No 31 – discussions are ongoing with A2B (the bus operator) regarding the bus timetable which routes the bus passed Shelford Primary School at critical times. Any changes need negotiation with CCC.

Mini Garage – Cllrs Arnold and Disley investigating, some discussions with the owner have taken place.

Verges – many verges, in particular in Cambridge Road are being damaged by “delivery vehicles” and in some cases “residents”. We need a discussion on a remedy, we could put small boulders on the worst cases as a trial? Spnd say £1000?
